

# Vegetable Clank Can

My fifth grade daughter Kalissa wrote a rhyme for me and I wanted to do something special with it so here's what I came up with. Take a baby formula can or tin coffee can with a lid. Cover the can with green construction paper. Attach the rabbit to the front and the rhyme on the back. Cover the can with clear contact paper. Put the lid on top and cut a slit in the plastic big enough for the lids to fit in. Print and cut out the "circle vegetables" below. Glue them onto tin can lids and cover them with clear contact paper. I have a Pampered Chef can opener that takes lifts the lid off rather than cuts it so the edges aren't sharp. Now lay the vegetables out on the table and sing the song. As you sing, have a child come up, select the vegetable you are singing about and drop it in the can. This type of activity is good at circle time and good working one on one with little ones. You could also print two pages of the circles and use them for a matching game.
